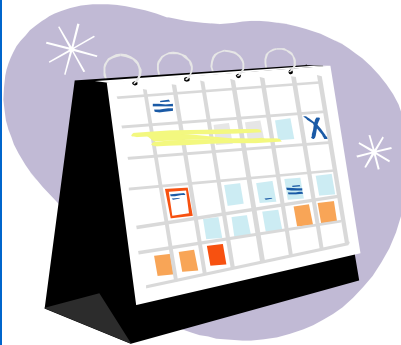
We will camp Fri & Sat night. We'll have a campfire and smores. If you do not wish to stay
